

Governors Report September 2018

It was another great year for PE during 17/18.

Excellent progress was made throughout the school during PE lessons with a number of credited awards being achieved.

These include -

Pupils have also achieved great things with their individual targets. These include during PE lessons, Physical development and rebound Therapy.

All pupils were offered at least one community Sporting activity/ event.

Over 30 events took place within the County and beyond.

A number of adventurous sporting activities were participated in including angling, trampolining, assault courses, tunnelling, Zip wires, archery, rifle shooting, martial arts, canoeing and rock climbing.

We are currently organising a Disability Sports Showcase where parents and children can come along and take part/ find out more about the various sports clubs and opportunities that are available to them. We are trying to get all of our pupils to be more active in out of school time.
